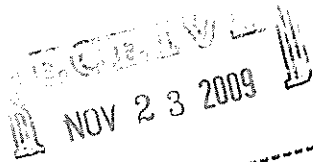


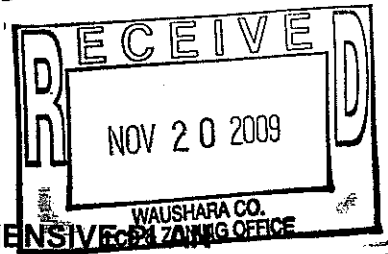

On 10-14-09 the Waushara County Land Use Committee and the Waushara County Land, Water, and Education Committee filed a request with the Waushara County Planning and Zoning Committee and was considered by the Waushara County Planning and Zoning Committee at a regular meeting held on 11-19-09.

Based on the facts and evidence presented, the Committee's decision was to recommend to the Waushara County Board of Supervisors that the Waushara County 20 Year Comprehensive Plan be approved.

The reasons for the Committee's decision were:

1. After reviewing the application and considering all related testimony, the 20 Year Comprehensive Plan, if approved, will not harm the public interest, but instead will benefit the county and its' citizens by aiding in the orderly development of unincorporated areas.
2. The proposed land use plan has been recommended for adoption by the Waushara County Land Use Committee, the Waushara County Land, Water, and Education Committee and meets the goals set forth in the Wisconsin Statutes.
3. All public notices, public participation requirements and state requirements have been complied with.

Therefore, the requested application is hereby **APPROVED** with the following conditions:

1. The Waushara County Planning and Zoning Committee recommends the Waushara County Board of Supervisors approve the recommended Comprehensive Plan with the change in the legend on the future land use map from "Commercial" to Commercial / Mixed Use".
2. The other recommendations in the 11-18-09 letter received from East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission are referred to the Waushara County Land Use Planning Committee for consideration at their next scheduled annual Comprehensive Plan Review Meeting.
3. The proposed comprehensive plan is now referred to the Waushara County Board of Supervisors, for their consideration.
