







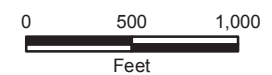


EXHIBIT 5-2 VILLAGE OF HANCOCK SOIL LIMITATIONS FOR ON-SITE WASTE DISPOSAL
