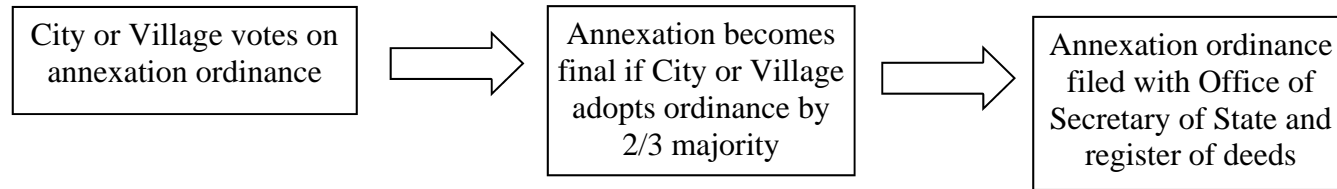


Annexation of Territory Owned by a City of Village

See section 66.0223 of the Wisconsin Statutes



Annexation of Territory Owned by a City of Village

- Initiated by the Village/City
- The land must be owned by the Village/City and lie near the village/city, but does not need to be contiguous to it
- Use of noncontiguous territory is not to be contrary to any Town or County zoning
- If the Village/City is not located in the same county as the proposed annexation area, the Town and the County board must adopt a resolution approving the proposed annexation for it to take place
