

Tri-County Area Population




Tri-County Area Change in Population







Estimated Waushara County Population 2016





(based on minimum 5 acre for new lots)








Waushara Population by Age







Waushara County, without Redgranite Prison Population by Ethnicity






Waushara County 2010 Population by Ethnicity



2000 Waushara County Hispanic/Latino Population that speak English and/or Spanish




2010 Waushara County Hispanic/Latino Population that speak English and/or Spanish







Hispanic Population Who Did Not Speak English "Well" in 2011




Number of Migrant Workers, Their Spouses, and Their Children








Waushara County, without Redgranite Prison Population by Race







2016 Waushara County Commodities Food Pantry Average Monthly Use







Average Wage Paid in the County in 2015 Dollars






Worker Flow





Percent of the Population over 25 Living with Poverty by Education Obtained








2000 Waushara County Population Age 25 and Over by Education Attainment

2010 Waushara County Population Age 25 and Over by Education Attainment




Average Monthly Employment and Annual Wage by Industry Sector for Public and Private Non-agriculture Jobs, 2015

Average Monthly Employment and Annual Wage for Manufacturing Sector, 2015






Average Monthly Employment and Annual Wage for Health Care and Social Assistance Sector, 2015





Average Monthly Employment and Annual Wage for Accommodation & Food Service Sector, 2015




Average Monthly Employment and Annual Wage for All Other Sectors, 2015
























Primary Market Areas for Grocery Stores in Waushara County


