


Tri-County Area Population




Waushara County, without Redgranite Prison Population by Race





Population Barriers to Service (Local)

Similarities

(as identified in the literature)

- Limited English-language proficiency
- Transportation
- Rigid work schedules
- Lack of service need, awareness, or access
- Discrimination/fear of legal consequences
- Community exclusion

Differences

(as a result of the research)

- Inability to obtain a valid driver's license (specific to Wisconsin)
- Changes in legislation that affect status and service access contribute to additional barriers (not explicitly stated in literature)




Waushara Population by Age







2010 Waushara County Children Percent of Children in Various Family Structures









Chart 1. Health & Wellness Issues









Average Wage Paid in the County in 2015 Dollars




Employment and Wages




Chart 3. Home & Family Issues




Chart 4. Agricultural Issues








A Slice through the Earth












Chart 5. Children & Teenagers Issues




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


Chart 7. Community Issues



